LOUISVILLE'S DERBY TOURNAMENT RULES (Please Keep These Rules For Your Information)

1. United States Bowling Congress (USBC) rules and regulations will govern this tournament. Tournament shall be open to all bowlers who are members of the USBC and an individual membership card must be shown by each bowler upon request to establish bowler's eligibility to participate. Bowlers not in possession of a current USBC membership card may establish eligibility to roll in this tournament upon payment of affiliate membership fees of \$21.00 for men, \$18.00 for women, or a \$5.00 participation fee per USBC Rule 300C. **This is a USBC sanctioned tournament.**
2. Unmarried grade and high school students under the age of 18 must have written consent of a parent or guardian before participating in this tournament. Such consent must be on file with the tournament committee at least one week before participation, unless the student is accompanied by a parent or guardian. In that case, the consent must be filed prior to the start of bowling. Employees of Executive Strike and Spare are not eligible to bowl in this tournament.
3. PBA members in the top 40 in the PBA earnings & the Top 20 in the PBA 50 earnings list for the 2016 Season on pba.com as of 1/1/17 are not allowed to bowl. All other PBA members are eligible to bowl but not more than 1 PBA member or PBA National Champion (Current member or not) are allowed per team/doubles event. Brackets: We have the right to limit the amount of Actual & Handicap Brackets that any person may enter. Please contact us with any questions
4. This tournament shall be a combined handicap-actual tournament with 80% of the prize money being paid as handicap prizes and 20% paid as actual prizes. At least one prize for each seven entries in the five-man team event, two-man (doubles), singles event and all events will be awarded with entries being permitted to win both ways. Handicap champions and prize winners shall be determined by adding the individual's actual series for three games to a handicap based on 90% of the difference of the individual's entering average and 220 per game for three game series.
5. All tournament entry forms are expected with the completed bowler information and appropriate entry fees. Bowlers who have not submitted a verified average in advance of their squad bowling time will use a 220 average, zero handicap, in brackets, jackpots, and the tournament proper. The entering tournament average shall be determined as follows. Notice: Bowlers submitting averages from Sport League must report this information and conform to rules 202 A & B for adjusting as per USBC sport bowling chart. **BOWLERS SUBMITTING INCORRECT AVERAGES ARE SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION.**
 - a. A bowler's highest book average based on 21 or more games in any sanctioned league rolling during the 2015-16 season will be used. If a bowler has a current season (2016-17) average of 21 games or more that is 10 pins higher than the bowler must use that average.
 - b. Bowlers who have not bowled 21 or more games in any one league during 2015-16 season prior to January 1, 2016, but have a verifiable previous season league average (2015-16) based on 21 or more games in any sanctioned league or a tournament average may submit most recent average to the Tournament Committee for their approval. **NO FIRST YEAR AVERAGE WILL BE ALLOWED.**
 - c. A bowler with no previous league or tournament experience shall use 220 as an average and receive 0 pins handicap.
6. USBC Rule 17 and USBC Rule 319 shall apply to all entrants and strictly enforced. According to USBC Rule 319, bowlers must adjust entering average and submit the adjusted average to the Tournament Committee if the accumulated average for all but not less than 21 tournament games, exceeds the average to be used by 15 or more pins. In that case, the adjusted average will be used as tournament average.
7. Bowlers will be REQUIRED to report tournament winnings of \$600.00 or more in accordance with USBC Rule 319D.
8. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to re-rate, prior to bowling of any **three game** set, the average of any bowler whose entering average is not comparable to his past tournament(s) average or does not reflect the bowler's true ability. If this re-rated average is not acceptable to the individual, the entry fee will be returned to the bowler. Bowlers re-rated in accordance with USBC Rule 319 are not eligible for refund of entry fee. Any bowler who has accepted or rejected a re-rate for any tournament must notify the Derby Tournament Committee or face DISQUALIFICATION.
9. In five-man team event, each team shall consist of five members, either all men, all women or mixed, who will bowl three games on a pair of lanes assigned. We will try to pair all teams as per the entry's request or by average when possible. NO BOWLER MAY ROLL MORE THAN FIVE TIMES IN THE TEAM EVENT. No more than three players on one team can place more than once in each the actual or handicap prize list for position standings. A man bowler may substitute for a woman or vice versa.
10. In minor events, each bowler shall bowl six games, alternating lanes each frame, on lanes assigned by computer or by tournament staff. The first bowler of each doubles pair shall start first game on left lane with the first three game series counting towards singles event. At the end of the three games, bowlers will start doubles event. If you enter doubles, YOU MUST enter the singles event. YOU MAY BOWL THREE TIMES IN MINOR EVENTS. You must change partners in order to cash twice.
11. All events consist of nine (9) games being bowled, , HIGH SERIES IN EACH EVENT SCORES GOES TOWARDS . All events entry can be transferred if transfer is made before either of the bowlers involved have participated in any event of the tournament.
12. After a team or double series has started no change can be made in the order of the players, but the captain can replace any player with a qualified substitute. A player removed during a game cannot return to bowl in that game. No substitution can be made on a singles event after the series has been started.
13. Bowlers will receive ten minutes of practice bowling before start of team event and singles event, but no practice before start of doubles event. If players have to change pair of lanes during a three game series they will receive two practice balls on each of the new lanes and resume bowling from point of the interruption.
14. Ball surface alterations are not allowed once an event begins. Singles and Doubles are bowled consecutively and are considered one event by the Tournament Staff therefore no ball alterations are allowed.
15. If it is necessary to disqualify a participant for violation of the tournament or USBC rules, a written notification will be given to the team captain and/or bowler who may appeal the decision to USBC bowling headquarters. The notice of appeal of the disqualification must be filed within ten (10) days from the date of notification with the appeal made in writing to USBC bowling headquarters with a copy of appeal being sent to the Tournament Committee.
16. Entry fee is \$35.00 per bowler per event with \$19.50 for bowling, fees and tournament expenses and the balance of \$15.50 will be returned 100% in prizes. All Events entry fee (Optional) is \$10.00 per individual with \$3.00 for tournament expenses and the balance \$7.00 returned 100% in prizes. **NO ENTRY ACCEPTED WITHOUT COMPLETED ENTRY BLANK AND ENTRY FEE. MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO "LOUISVILLE DERBY TOURNAMENT". ENTRIES PRESENTING A BAD CHECK WILL BE CHARGED \$30.00 TO COVER BANK CHARGES AND EXPENSES PER BAD CHECK. ENTRIES ISSUING BAD CHECKS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO BOWL UNTIL CHECK IS MADE GOOD.**
17. COMPLETED ENTRY BLANK listing team lineup and/or doubles with bowlers names, addresses and social security number MUST include total entry fee (no partial fees are accepted NO EXCEPTIONS). Teams or groups wishing to bowl together should indicate so on entry blank. Reserved entries will be held without entry fee until March 1, 2017. After this date entry fee must cover the reservation. Spots reserved and not paid for will be available on a first come first serve basis.
18. The Automatic Scorers are the official scorekeepers for the tournament. All team captains and participants MUST CHECK in with Tournament Committee at least 60 minutes prior to their scheduled time of bowling. All entries, excluding those requesting to be paired together at time of entry, will be paired by the Tournament Committee. Tournament computer program and/or tournament committee will assign lanes for team event and singles event competition. Squad shall be started on time or immediately thereafter when lanes are available. Tardy bowlers will not be permitted to "Catch-up" frames missed and will start to bowl and their score count in the frame being bowled. Bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn or receive "ZERO" for frame missed. Minor events bowlers must stay in pit area unless granted permission to leave area. S & S is a family bowling center, proper attire is required. The tournament manager has full discretion regarding what is proper attire. No profanity will be tolerated.
19. Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any or all entries and will decide all questions or disputes arising in the tournament and their decision will be final, subject to USBC appeal.
20. The contestants whose name appears on the entry blank or their authorized substitutes hereby agree that the management of the Tournament and its agents shall not be liable if and when entry shall be prevented from bowling in this tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary scheduled changes, or premature termination of the Tournament brought about by war, fire, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes then foregoing prize lists to be prorated in accordance with the respective events rolled up to time of termination.
21. Official prize list and checks will be distributed SEPTEMBER 5, 2017. **(All prize checks will be mailed to each individual.)**
